

Open Call for Prague Quadriennale'19



Hungarian interdisciplinary artist **David Somló** is looking for performers to participate in his new public space piece 'Drift', which will be premiered in the Prague Quadriennale'19, Formation section. The performance will consist a 45-60 minutes long minimalist choreography of walking. During the performance each of the 15 performers will carry around a portable speaker creating an immersive soundscape to the audience.

Practical Details:

- You'll need to be available on the 11th (general rehearsal), 12th, 13th (performances) of June, each day 4 hours (7:30-11:30AM).
- There is a small honorary of 50 euros, that you will receive upon your participation on all three dates.
- There will be a rehearsal on the afternoon of the 12th of May. This is optional, but preferable.
- You don't need previous experience in performing.

About the artist:

David Somló is a Hungarian interdisciplinary artist working with space, sound and interaction. In his artistic practice he is interested in those human interactions that are small but significant, as well as the exploration of audience perception, utilizing both time and performance spaces. He composes situations.
