

I'm looking for 6-7 people to help perform Tangled.

Performers needed who are happy with pedestrian-based activities such as walking, standing, kneeling, rolling and lying down .

Tangled is a performative durational creative work which explores the notion of the unpredictable and quirky within the nocturnal environments of Prague and the Prague Exhibition Grounds. Tangled is based on mutating cancer cells and consists of up to four inflatable and illuminated suits which are inhabited by two performers each. The suits are inflated, encumbering the people wearing them and forcing them to move in ways which are clumsy, ungainly and unpredictable. Moving through the night time environment of Prague and the Prague Exhibition Grounds also creates challenges of navigation, encounter and the potential for failure.

No talking or singing is required. Experience performing is a great bonus. So dancers, Gymnasts, Circus artists, Yogi's would be great. Being comfortable being seen and making fool of yourself a bonus. Other than that no special skills are needed apart from an ability to walk.

As we move around Prague, we will encounter other performers, installations, members of the public and the environment around Prague's exhibition grounds. We won't be totally sure what will eventuate, however it promises to be disruptive, confusing, fun and a little odd.
